Lesson	Topic / Theme / Vocabulary	Grammar Point / Verbs
Lesson 1	Introductions, meeting and greeting, alphabet, numbers 0-10, names for everyday objects	Masculine/Feminine – un/una Verb to be - ser
Lesson 2	Jobs and professions, countries and nationalities, family	Verb to have – tener Masculine/Feminine – el/la los/las
Lesson 3	Food and drink, ordering in a restaurant Saying what you would like	Verb to want – querer Negatives
Lesson 4	Making friends, saying where you live, spelling your address, numbers 11-1000	Verb to live – vivir Hay – there is/ there are
Lesson 5	Saying where things are, prepositions of place – in, on, next to, near, far	Verb to be – estar (compared with ser)
Lesson 6	Asking for directions, names of places in a town – bank, supermarket etc	Asking questions for directions, following directions
Lesson 7	Revision of first lessons, booking into a hotel, facilities in a hotel	Prepositions – para How much / how many
Lesson 8	The home – describing facilities of a house or flat, adjectives to describe a house eg large, small, beautiful	Adjectives – masculine, feminine, singular and plural

Lesson 9	Everyday activities – work, eat, drink, read, listen Saying where you do the activities	Verbs to work, to eat, to drink, to read, to listen - trabajar, comer, beber, leer, escuchar Questions with when
Lesson 10	Telling the time, saying what time you do activities	Verbs – to get up, to go to bed – reflexive verbs Verb forms – to go, to leave, to do, to come back - irregular
Lesson 11	The supermarket – buying food, asking how much it costs Food vocabulary	Quantities – metric measurements, masculine, feminine and plural of ‘how much’
Lesson 12	Further shopping – clothes, souvenirs Revision of everything covered so far	Verbs to open, to close, to start, to finish – abrir, cerrar, empezar, terminar

In each lesson we will aim to cover the skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing as well as a key aspect of grammar.
