Lesson 3	The verb "to have - MIEC". Exercises, reading and creating sentences with the verb "to have" - practise Polish sounds.	Using the correct form of to have in the sentences.
Lesson 4	The verb NAZYWAC SIE" (to be called). Exercises, reading and creating sentences, practise Polish sounds.	Using the correct form of this verb in the sentences.
Lesson 5	Questions about Family. Possessive pronouns mój, moja, moje Twój, Twoja, Twoje. Exercises, reading and creating sentences about family and friends - practise Polish sounds.	Using the nouns linked with the Family subject.
Lesson 6	Pragmatic personal verbs categories. Classes 1-2 of verbs.	Practise present tense.

Lesson 12	Traveling to Poland (hotel, train station, restaurant, shopping). Exercises, reading and creating sentences about travel to Poland.	Using the correct form of nouns. Using known verbs.
