

Language Course Syllabus

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Subject: Signing for All (British Sign Language) – Improvers Course (immediate communication).

Aims: To enable communication through British Sign Language. More and manage confidence to meet deaf people.

Objectives: By the end of session, the students will be able to:-

- Sign approximately 350 words
- Finger spell their names, vocabulary
- Conversation and repeat a short/long story telling
- Answer questions about everyday life in current news, weather & feelings/emotions.
- Demonstrate some deaf ways and deaf culture

Lessons	Topic / Vocabulary	Grammar / Functional Language
Lesson 1 and then every week	Introduce Calendar/Dairy – Days of the Week and Months of the Year.	Get to know each other. Conversation and check others with their names, lives and asks meet deaf/hearing before. Any polish up with fingerspelling. Demo and then asks clarify about doing what during weekly, months and a year.
Lessons 2 & 3	Calendar/Dairy – Days of the Week and Months of the Year.	Recap and practice increase then asks clarify about doing what during weekly, months and a year.
Lesson 4	Planning to Meet up Q&A Affirmative & Negative signs	Demo, understand how student meet up with time, place & weather.
Lessons 5 & 6	Weather/Season Weather/Season – story telling	Describe and ask about the weather. Describe different types of weather.
Lessons 7, 8	Interests, hobbies, activities and sports. Sign Principles - Handshapes & Classifiers	Give, ask for and understand into about interests, hobbies, activities and sports. BSL handshapes to match and vision of all aspects of topics.
Lesson 9	Recap with Lesson 1 to 8 as above. Fingerspell with respective skills.	To be revise of all previous handouts and any clarify of BSL signs and polish up.
Lessons 10, 11	Emotions and Feelings	Give, ask for and understand information about emotions and feeling. To increase with face expression when something is bad.
Lesson 12	Future BSL course discussion. Games Goodbye!	Give, ask for and understand information about future BSL course. Choose any BSL games.
